4. **Course Applications and Allocation.** A calling notice is distributed to interested countries two months before courses are scheduled requesting applications for vacancies. All courses are open to participation by international and Kenyan students and instructors. Course Places are normally allocated on a 'first come' basis although countries are normally restricted to numbers of students. Priority is given to students expected to be involved in UN/AU missions shortly after the course.

5. **Numbers of Students.** PSTC Karen can accommodate up to 50 residential students and DS on each course, with an additional 20 non-residential students. Maximum course size is 70 personnel per course. Average and preferred course size is 50 including DS.
